

## Kentucky guidelines on how to dispense and distribute medications for opioid use disorder (MOUD)

Opioid treatment programs are called "narcotic treatment programs." The <u>Kentucky Cabinet for Health and Family Services</u> manages applications. The programs are overseen by the state narcotic authority (SNA): <u>Department for Behavioral Health, Developmental and Intellectual Disabilities</u>
