

## Ohio guidelines on how to dispense and distribute medications for opioid use disorder (MOUD)

Registering to be an OTP: A Certification Application needs to be completed and submitted to OHMHAS

Ohio Administrative Code 5122-40-10: Methadone Treatment License. Revised code effective June 29, 2019.

Ohio Revised Code 5119.37: Requirements to operate opioid addiction treatment programs. An opioid treatment program directly operated by the Department of Veteran's Affairs, the Indian Health Service or any other department or agency of the United States is not required to obtain a state license.

## Ohio Revised Code 340.01:

An alcohol, drug addiction, and mental health service district shall be established in any county or combination of counties having a population of at least fifty thousand. With the approval of the director of mental health and addiction services, any county or combination of counties having a population of less than fifty thousand may establish such a district. Districts comprising of more than one county shall be known as joint-county districts.

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
